### Personal, Social & Emotional development

Become familiar with classroom routines and expectations.  
Form new friendships with peers and adults.  
Take part in turn taking games.  
Develop confidence in new situations.  
Develop independence skills.

### Communication & Language

Develop listening skills.  
Join in with rhymes and stories  
Use language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences in the role play.  
Talk about their ideas, feelings and events.  
Retell a simple rhyme in the correct order.



### Physical Development

Handle tools, objects, construction and malleable materials safely and with increasing control.  
Begin to form recognisable letters.  
Experiment moving around in different ways.



### Understanding of the World

Talk about significant events in their own experiences.  
Share special times or events from family celebrations.  
Talk about some of the things they have observed such as plants, animals.  
Show care and concern for living things and the environment.  
Complete simple programmes on the laptop, using the touch mouse.

### Mathematics

Play games to help recognise numbers.  
Put numbers in order.  
Count how many objects.  
Join in with number rhymes.  
Name different shapes.  
Use length language.



## Autumn 1 – Rhyme Time

### Literacy



Become familiar with different rhymes.  
Develop knowledge of letter sounds.  
Play rhyming and sound games.  
Play games to hear and say the initial sounds in words.  
Recognise and write own name.  
Develop writing skills.  
Recognise characters from the reading scheme.

### Expressive Arts & Design

Join in with singing and dancing games.  
Sing familiar songs. And rhymes.  
Build using different construction materials.  
Uses simple tools such as pencils, brushes and scissors.
