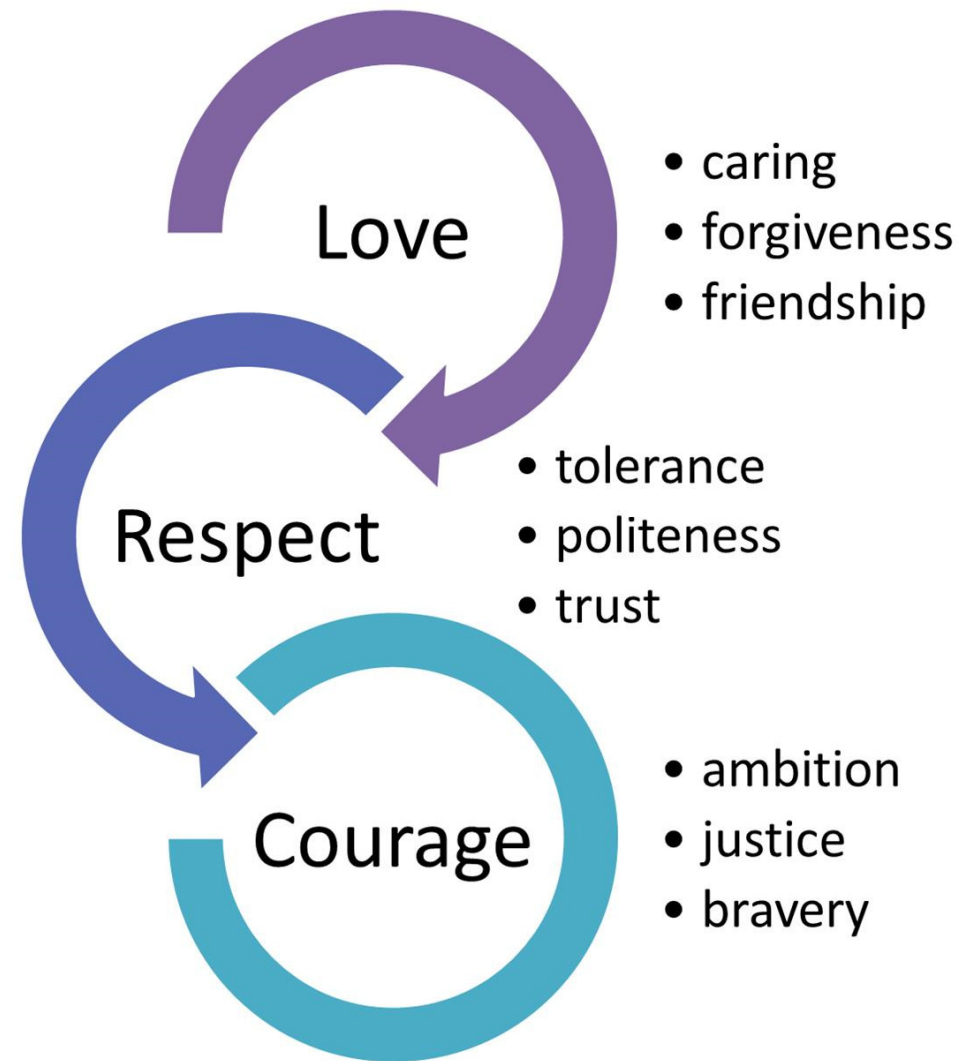

Maths

In Maths we will be improving the speed of our mental arithmetic and recapping efficient written methods for the four operations. We will be learning how to use and follow algebraic equations.

English

In English we will be reading Wonder and They Day the Crayons quit. Our focus is going to be on how we plan and edit our writing as well as to work on our persuasive and narrative writing skills.

Computing

We will be looking at how to stay safe on the internet and social media sites.

Science

Children will be learning about evolution and inheritance in our science lessons. We will be exploring information that can be gathered from fossils as well as how animals are adapted to their environments.

History

Children will continue their chronological knowledge and their understanding of world history through their investigations of the Jurassic era.

Autumn 1 – Jurassic Coast

RE

We will be looking at Islam, including the Islamic ritual of Wudu.

PE

Children will be working with wall bars to investigate symmetry and body shape. We will also be working on team skills through tag rugby.

Music

We will be exploring beat and syncopation through song and body percussion.

Geography

Children will be learning how to read maps in order to locate countries and cities. They will also be planning routes for them to follow around Bramley.

Art and Design

We will be designing and creating our own clay dinosaurs.

Foreign Language

Children will continue to develop their knowledge and confidence of both written and oral French.

do have set PE days each week, however if we are unable to complete outdoor PE on a specific day we may move it to another time. Please ensure your child has the correct kit in a named bag.

Children are expected to bring in their PE on a Monday and take it home on a Friday.

Indoor: Navy shorts with school light blue PE Shirt

Outdoor: As indoor, together with a change of socks, training shoes/ plimsolls.

In winter, the children may well become cold, wet and muddy. A complete change of kit is essential. Plain navy or black tracksuits and jumpers. (without obvious logos) may be worn in cold weather.

Spellings are set alongside the English homework.

All homework is stuck into an English or Maths homework book.

Homework Guidance



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Homework should take about 30-40 minutes.

If you are unsure about any homework. For example: Using Chunking for division or Column method for multiplication, please ask your child's teacher.
