

#### Maths

n Maths we will be improving the speed of our mental arithmetic and recapping efficient written methods for the four operations. We will be learning how to use and follow algebraic equations.

#### English

In English we will be reading Wonder and They Day the Crayons quit. Our focus is going to be on how we plan and edit our writing as well as to work on our persuasive and narrative writing skills.

#### Computing

We will be looking at how to stay safe on the internet and social media sites.

#### Science

Children will be learning about evolution and inheritance in our science lessons. We will be exploring information that can be gathered from fossils as well as how animals are adapted to their environments.

#### **History**

Idren will continue their chronological nowledge and their understanding of world history through their investigations of the Jurassic era.

#### Geography

ildren will be learning how to read ps in order to locate countries and cities. They will also be planning outes for them to follow around Bramley.


