## EXTRA-CURRICULAR CLUBS – Autumn Term 2022

I am pleased to be able to provide you with details of the programme of extra-curricular clubs for this term and hope very much your child will wish to take advantage of the opportunities on offer. We also have a great selection of externally run clubs happening this term.

Rugby, ball games and football will start the week commencing Monday 26th September 2022

Makaton & Netball will start the week commencing Monday 31st October 2022.

The last week for all school led clubs will be Monday 5th December 2022.

Could I please ask you to take careful note of the following points:

- Joining a school club should be seen as a commitment and therefore regular attendance is expected. If for some reason a child is unable to attend a particular session they should inform the member of staff responsible for running the club; should the child wish to leave the club they should also inform the member of staff.
- After-school clubs start immediately after school and end at 4.10pm (unless otherwise stated). Arrangements should be made to pick your child up. Please note that parents waiting to pick children up should wait <u>outside</u> the classroom door or the external hall door, where the club is taking place.
- We will endeavour to run all clubs throughout the duration and ensure that clubs are
  not cancelled on the day of the club itself. However, if extenuating circumstances
  dictate, a club may have to be cancelled at short notice. In these circumstances
  parents will be sent a text message as early in the day as possible.
- Some clubs have a maximum number of children that can be catered for. In the
  event of a club being oversubscribed, we may decide to split the club into two shorter
  periods if suitable or, alternatively, "lots" will be drawn and additional children put on
  a "waiting list" or accommodated at a later date.
- For clubs held outside in the event of wet weather: if the activity cannot take place inside due to suitability or lack of free space then the children will be otherwise entertained until 4.10pm. If you would like to pick your child up please do so via reception at 3.15pm after they have been registered.

providers carry a fee. Contact details for external clubs are listed on the timetable.
Please contact the provider for charges. Any clubs that charge a fee to join are
marked with a \* on the timetable included.
