Communication & Language

The children will learn about their journey into Year 1. They will listen, make comments and hold conversations about this transition as well as expressing their ideas, feelings and explanations about the journey.

Personal, Social and Emotional development

While talking about their journey to Year 1, the children will also show an understanding of the feelings of others, be confident to try new activities and play cooperatively and take turns with others, forming new relationships with adults and peers.

Physical Development

The children will negotiate space, demonstrate strength and move energetically through classroom yoga, indoor and outdoor PE sessions. They will learn to hold a pencil correctly, use a range of small tools and show accuracy when drawing.

Understanding the World

In their play, children will learn about the past and present, people, culture and communities and the natural world. They will learn about diversity and inclusion through a range of texts and share their journey of life so far.

EYFS Summer 2 – Journeys

Expressive Arts & Design

The children will share their creations made and explain the processes they have used. They will have a range of props to role play fiction and non fiction texts and perform songs, poems and stories with the rest of the class.

Literacy

After our visit to the Watercress Line, the children will create a book to remember and tell others about their experience. They will write sentences about their day, and read them to other children. They will ask and answer questions about their journey.

Mathematics

The children will consolidate their knowledge of number bonds and composition of numbers to 10 using resources and videos to support their learning. Numberblocks resources will be available for the children to explore in their free flow time as well as numicon, bead strings, tens frames and cubes.
