### Maths

This term we will be recapping the four operations. We will then focus on the properties of shapes, discussing the terminology of right angles, Obtuse angles and acute angles. We will be comparing these angles as well as finding them within shapes. After this, we will develop our measurement skills focusing on mass and capacity and adding different measurements together to find totals.

### Science

This half we will be discovering how animals and human receive nutrition from different types of food. We will discuss the different consumer groups and the animals that fall under each bracket. We will go on to learn about the human anatomy, how muscles and bones help us move around and produce everyday tasks.

### Geography.

This half term we will be learning all about where our food comes from! We will be discussing different countries around the world and the ingredients that are grown there. We will also be looking at some of the most popular dishes in each country.

### English

Through our reading, we will be developing a range of thinking skills linked to texts such as *Perfectly Peculiar Plants* and *Saturday at the food Pantry*. Our writing will include writing our own instructions, Writing poetry about our favourite foods, a short story and inventing our own peculiar plants!

### R.E
