School Dinners...

We have noticed that a growing number of children are changing 'pre-ordered' lunches on the ScoPay system. While we have accepted this so far, as of Monday we will be stopping it.

We are concerned that where a parent may have ordered a hot dinner for the child (as they have a busy evening or they will only be having a smaller dinner) they could swap to a sandwich option without home adults knowing.

Please could we ask that parents make sure their children know what has been ordered and help them to understand why. Our difficulty at school is that if a child says they don't like the option, we will not be able to let them change.

Bringing items to school...

Please can you support your children to not bring toys, teddies, games or any jewellery to school. These items can easily be lost or unfortunately broken which can lead to very upset children. We have had several instances recently which have distracted from learning time or happy play times because of items from home. Thank you

Free Leavers...

With signed parental permission, children in KS2 are able to be free-leavers from the classroom door. As a school, we expect:

- children in Yr3 & Yr4 to be meeting an adult within the school grounds. We do not believe that children of that age should be leaving the school area without adult supervision.
- if your child is in Yr5 or Yr6, please ensure they know where you will meet them / where they should walk to each day. We have had concerns recently that some children aren't sure if they are walking straight home or meeting parents somewhere else and 'wander' at the end of the day.

If we have ongoing concerns about a child's end of day arrangements, we can revoke 'free-leaver' permissions.

Coin Wars...

The BSA's latest endeavour to support the school by raising money is well underway! As well as fundraising, it's a great opportunity for children to get used to handling 'real' money. Very well done everyone for digging out those coins to add to the pots.
